Parental Responsibilities:

- 1. Ensure that your student attends each lesson on time.
- 2. Cancel lessons by email or text with at least 24 hours notice.
- Familiarize yourself with the attendance policy.
- 3. Make tuition payments by the first lesson of each month.
- Familiarize yourself with the tuition policy.
- A tuition reminder will be emailed each month. Check your email regularly.
- 4. Give at least one month's notice, if your student wishes to discontinue lessons.
- One month's tuition is due for lessons discontinued with less than one month's notice.
- 5. Provide the necessary materials, including a fine playable instrument in good repair, legally purchased or downloaded (not photocopied or illegally downloaded) sheet music, music stand, metronome, and tuner, as advised.
- Consultations for the purchase of new instruments are absolutely encouraged and available at a flat fee. (See "Tuition")
- Arrange for your students' instrument to have a yearly clean, oil, and adjust with a recommended repair professional.
- 6. Support an environment that encourages regular practice.
- 7. Keep in regular communication with both instructor and student about their progress and goals.
- 8. Keep your email address, phone number, and other contact information up-todate with Ms. Goodman, and check your email regularly for studio communication.
- 9. Bookmark <u>the studio calendar</u> and blog for regular checks.
