Instructor Responsibilities:

Help each flutist achieve their personal musical potential and embrace their love of music and the flute!

Assist each flutist in developing life skills including self-discipline, responsibility, goal-setting, independence, self-esteem, and appreciation of music through flute study!

Provide regularly-scheduled 30-, 45-, or 60-minute lessons.

Cancel or reschedule lessons by email or text with at least 24 hours notice.

- With the exception of illness or emergency, all cancellations will be with a week's notice or more.
- Lessons missed due to teacher absence will be made up.

Utilize excellent, level-appropriate teaching methods, materials, music, and literature for warm-ups, scales, exercises, etudes, solos, and ensembles for each flutist.

Expose each flutist to the elements of good musicianship through the use of proper breathing, posture, tone, intonation, dynamics, phrasing, articulation, vibrato, and technique as applicable.

Encourage and extend musical literacy, theory, history, and awareness.

Prepare students for auditions, competitions, adjudications, masterclasses, festivals, honors opportunities, and performances as appropriate.

Publicize concerts, events, and musical opportunities related to flutists' musical studies.

Maintain the studio website, calendar, and blog to keep caregivers and flutists informed of scheduling and newsworthy events.
