

# **Lindsey J. Goodman Flute Studios Policies 2021 - 2022**

## **Teacher Responsibilities:**

1. Provide regularly-scheduled 30-, 45-, or 60-minute lessons.
2. Cancel lessons by email or text with at least 24 hours notice.
  - With the exception of illness or emergency, all cancellations will be with a week's notice or more.
  - Lessons missed due to teacher absence will be made up.
  - Make-up sessions for face-to-face lessons may be conducted virtually, if a mutually-available in-person date and time is not available.
3. Utilize the finest teaching methods, materials, music, and literature available for warm-ups, scales, etudes, exercises, solos, and ensembles for each lesson.
4. Expose the student to the elements of good musicianship through the use of proper breathing, posture, tone, intonation, dynamics, phrasing, articulation, vibrato, and technique.
5. Encourage and extend musical literacy, theory, and awareness.
6. Encourage the student to develop life skills including discipline, responsibility, goal-setting, and self-esteem through music study.
7. Prepare the student for auditions, competitions, adjudications, masterclasses, festivals, honors opportunities, and performances as appropriate.
8. Publicize concerts, events, and opportunities related to the student's musical studies.
9. Maintain the studio website, calendar, and blog to keep students and parents informed of scheduling and noteworthy events.
